



## IT'S TIME OUR CHILDREN HAD THE EDUCATION THEY DESERVE

**This week we stand with our primary colleagues, who are currently in a week of one-day rolling strikes. Area schools will be negotiating our collective agreements next year. We face many of the same issues as the ones you are hearing about in primary.**

You send your children to school for the quality education they deserve and need to set them up for life. Yet, schools are facing a teacher shortage crisis, with a 40% drop in people training to be teachers; and a growing number of school-aged children. Earlier this year in term 3, 50% of schools reported that they did not have enough teachers. Schools are struggling to attract staff to teach our children, and that problem looks set to worsen in time.

The Government has recently announced some new resource, in response to the desperate need for additional help for children with additional learning needs being raised in the campaign.

Class sizes are too big to give your kids the education they deserve. Research shows that what works for children is smaller classes and more one-on-one learning with their teachers.

Yet, the Government have a bumper unexpected surplus of \$5.5 billion. A fraction of this would fix the issues in primary education (\$0.9b).
